Where can I take the ATS Qualifying Exam?

AT YOUR SCHOOL:

The *College Ability Test* is taken by more than 6,000 students at hundreds of Sacramento schools between January and March. Check with your school to see if they are offering the test. A \$15 processing fee is payable on the day of the test at school sites.

AT SACRAMENTO STATE:

Testing is also available at Sac State on the following Saturdays: **February 12, February 26, March 5, and March 19.** A \$15 processing fee is payable the day of the test. Contact ATS to reserve your place.

Costs and Financial Aid

ATS is a non-profit, self-supporting organization and receives no federal or state funding. In 2010, course fees for the 6-9 program ranged from \$114 to \$399, depending on the length of the course. For the 4/5 week-long sessions, course fees were \$235.

Over \$49,000 in financial support was granted to students last year. Financial aid information will be included in the *2011 Catalog*, which will be mailed to students and available online in March 2011.

Classes
